


Our very own artist

Easy Creamy potato bake

8 potatoes large unpeeled washed thinly sliced

- 250g cheese grated
- 500g bacon rashers chopped
- 300ml thickened cream
- 1 tbs Dijon mustard

Steps

- 1. Place a layer of potatoes in a baking dish.
- 2. Sprinkle a layer of cheese over the potato slices.
- 3. Sprinkle bacon over the cheese.
- 4. Continue these steps and finish with extra cheese on the top.
- Mix cream and mustard together and pour over the top.
- Bake at 220C for 45 minutes, then again at 180C for 30-40 minutes, until potatoes are soft and cheese has browned.
